

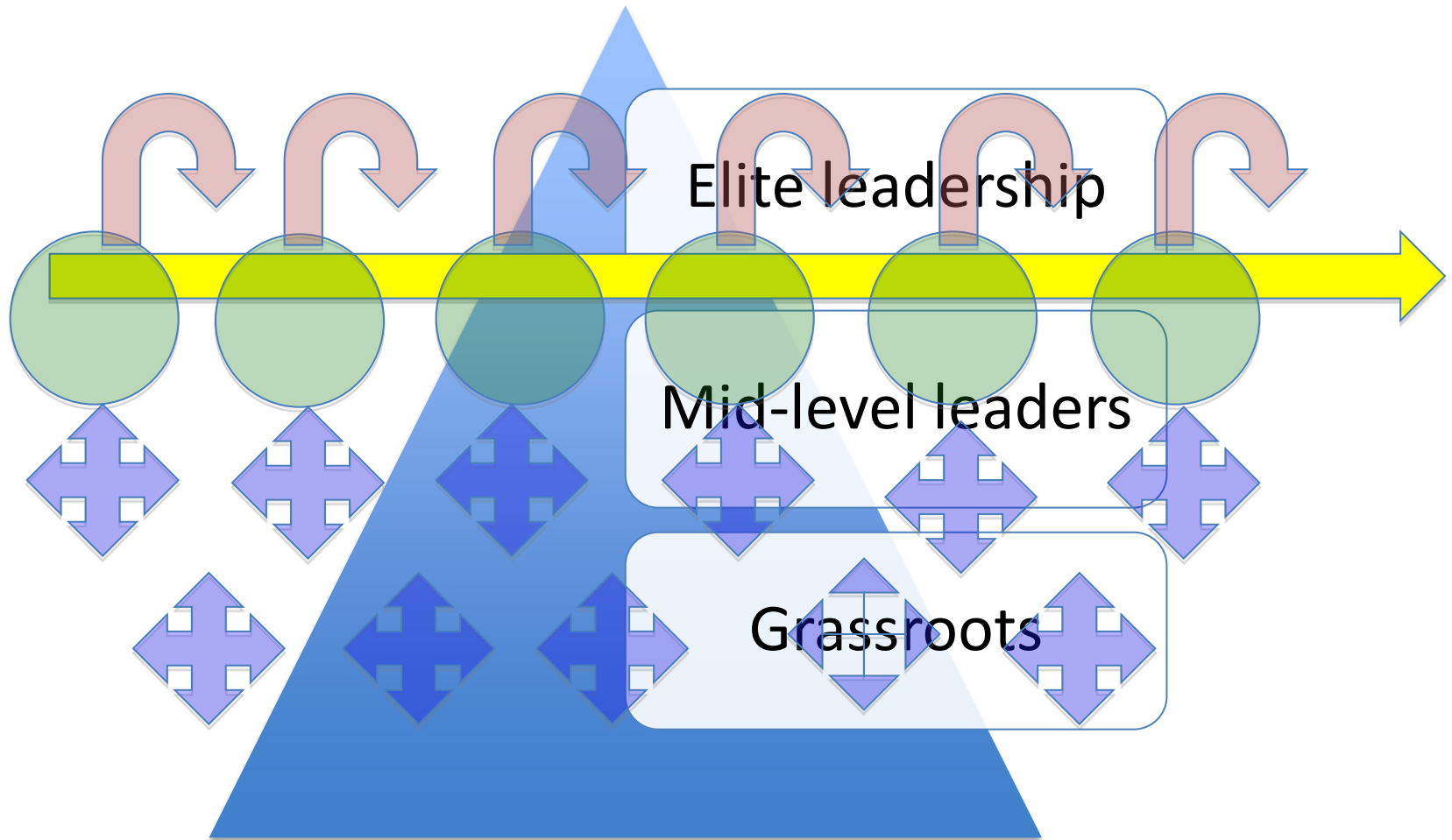

Track 1 ½ with South Ossetians

- 1996-1999: Five senior level unofficial meetings convened by CMG
- 2000-2005: Quiet
- 2005-2006: Three senior level unofficial meetings convened by IISS
- 2007-2008: No ongoing processes
- 2008-2012: Point of View process
